Enough total units to reach 120 minimum for graduation; 40 units minimum at the upper division level; to include the following:

University-wide requirements: 0-3 units

- ENG 214 if not completed prior to transfer (As noted above, students who have not completed the equivalent of ENG 214 before transfer must wait
 until the second semester to take LS 300GW)
- Following the recommendations above, students will fulfill Upper Division GE in the 2nd semester by choosing Major Core courses that also satisfy UD GE, areas B, C and D.
- Students entering this major with the AA-T in Elementary Education are not required to fulfill SF State Studies requirements; also, because of the interdisciplinary nature of the major, students will automatically fulfill the Complementary Studies requirement.
